During his time in Canada he was instrumental in launching the first student magabook program for the country, training 500 students who earned over \$1 million for their schooling. He now pastors 4 churches in central Pennsylvania where he continues pursuing his passion of reaching people with the everlasting gospel as presented in the three angels messages of Revelation chapter 14.
